GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Location

The meeting will be held on the Range at Pitch Place, Worplesdon Road (A322)

Parking

Parking will be in the range car park,

Reception

Competitors should report to the club house on arrival to collect their targets and competitors number.

Targets

The NSRA 1989 Series targets will be used. Competitors must write the detail time, firing point on each card and backer.

Rules

All shooting will be governed by NSRA rules except where otherwise stated. Any disputes will be decided by three or more members of the Range Committee. The range committee shall consist of the Meeting Organiser or his deputy in his absence and the members of the Executive Committee of the Surrey County Small Bore Rifle Association.

Results

Results will be displayed in the club room. Scores will be recorded as points dropped. **Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their scores are correctly recorded before leaving the meeting.**

Challenges

A score may be challenged on payment of 50p which will be refunded if the challenge is upheld. Challenges must be made within 30 minutes of scores being posted after the last detail of the day. No score may be challenged after the close of the meeting.

Fees

Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the full fee. Entry fees will only be returned if the organiser is informed 48 hours before the start of the meeting and subject to an administration fee of £1.

Ammunition

No ammunition will be available for sale at Worplesdon,

Refreshments - Light refreshments will be available.

Classification

All competitors, other than Class A, must return an up to date declaration of their current short range average (15, 20 or 25 yards). This average must be certified by the Secretary or Captain of the competitor's club. The onus rests on the competitor to ensure a correct declaration is given. If no average is submitted the competitor will be placed in Class A. If there are 5 or less entries in Classes C & D these will be combined. **Those competitors in the leading two places in Classes B, C & D of last year's Meeting will be promoted one class for this meeting .**

The Range Committee reserves the right to reclassify a competitor at any time. Classification will be based on the following averages and should be calculated on the best 10 of the last 12 cards at 15, 20 or 25 yards (NSRA BM89 Series targets).

Class A - 98.0 and over

Class B - 96.5 and below 98.0

Class C - 94.5 and below 96.5

Class D - below 94.5

SQUADDING

All shooting will be squadded - except for Competition 10.

Competitors must book their squadding in advance on their entry form. Competitors failing to shoot at their allocated time may only shoot at an alternative time subject to the discretion of the Range Committee. Any change to allocated details must first be agreed by the Range Committee.

Please ensure you include a SAE or e-mail address for confirmation of squadding time.

Shooting times

Shooting will commence at 9.30am each day and will continue without a lunch break until the end of the last detail. Times may be extended at the discretion of the Range Committee.

Squad and Detail times

All details will be of 20 minutes duration. Ten minutes will be allowed between details to allow for target changing and moving equipment.

Sighters

Sighters will be unlimited within the 20 minutes shooting period.

Left handed shooters

Left-handed shooters will be allocated the right-hand side of the range.

Disabled shooters

Please notify the Meeting Organiser of any special requirements.

Personal equipment

Personal wind indicators are not permitted, but wind indicators will be provided. Competitors should provide their own shooting mat. Telescopic sights may only be used in Competition 10.

Liability

Neither the Surrey County Small Bore Rifle Association nor Worplesdon accept any liability whatsoever for any loss of, or damage to, equipment used, stored or left on the range.

Medals

The description of medals refers to the colour and not the metal content.

SHOOTING PROGRAMME

Comp 1 - **40 shots** at 50 yards

Comp 2 - **40 shots** at 100 yards.

Comp 3 - **Aggregate** of Comps 1 and 2

Comp 4 - **The Dewar.** 20 shots at 50 yards and 20 shots at 100 yards.

The above competitions will be in 4 classes

Comp 5 - **The Minors.** Open to competitors under the age of 15 years on the day of shooting. 20 shots at 50 yards. Concurrent with the first card of the 50 yards section of Comp 1 if this is entered.

Comp 6 - **The Juniors.** Open to competitors under the age of 18 years on the day of shooting. 40 shots at 50 yards. Concurrent with the first two cards of the 50 yards section of Comp 1 if this is entered.

Comp 7 - **Junior Aggregate.** Awarded to the highest scoring competitor under the age of 18 years on the day of shooting in competition 3.

Comp 8 - **The Veterans.** Awarded to the highest scoring competitor who have reached the age of 60 years or over on the day of shooting in competition 3.

Comp 9 - **The Ladies.** Awarded to the highest scoring female competitor in competition 3.

Comp 10 - **Any Sights Unsquadded.** 40 shots at 100 yds

Comp 15- **Club Secretaries & Treasurers.** Awarded to the highest scoring Secretary or Treasurer of a Club affiliated to the Surrey County Small-Bore Rifle Association. Concurrent with Competition 3

IN THE FOLLOWING COMPETITIONS COMPETITORS MAY ONLY SHOOT FOR THE CLUB SPECIFIED ON THEIR ENTRY FORMS.

Comp 11 - **Club Pairs.** Concurrent with Comp 3

Comp 12 - **50 yard Club Teams.** Team of 3. (Concurrent with Comp 1)

Comp 13 - **100 yard Club Teams.** Team of 3. (Concurrent with Comp 2)

Comp 14 - **Aggregate Club team.** Teams of 3. (Concurrent with Comp 3)

NOTE: Above Team and Pairs competitions must be nominated before any member shoots
