Lord Roberts Centre, Bisley – Sunday 2nd July 2017



GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Location:** The meeting will be held on the Malcolm Cooper Range, Lord Roberts Centre, Bisley Camp
- Reception:** On arrival, competitors should report to the Reception Desk which will be located inside the Malcolm Cooper Range.
- Targets:** All competitions will be shot on electronic scoring targets.
- Rules:** All shooting will be governed by ISSF (2017) rules as modified by the rules of the Surrey County Small Bore Rifle Association (SCSBRA) except there will be no Equipment Control or Finals. Prone rifle scores will be ranked in decimal.
- Protests:** Any protests will be decided by three members of the Range Committee, which shall comprise the Meeting Organiser and two holders of ISSF Judges licences. Range Committee decisions are final.
- Results:** Results will be displayed on the monitors during the meeting and published on SCSBRA's website as soon as possible after the meeting. Competitors will receive individual result sheets.
- Fees:** Participation in an event is conditional upon the full entry fee having been received by the Organiser at least 7 days before the start of the meeting, either by cheque or BACS. Unpaid entries will be removed from the start lists to allow other competitors to compete in popular events. Full or partial entry fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances.
- Ammunition:** Ammunition will be on sale in the NSRA shop at the Lord Roberts Centre during its normal opening times.
- Classification:** **All events: 50m prone, 50m Pistol and Rifle 3 Positions events will be shot in single classes.**
- Eligibility:** SCSBRA trophies will only be awarded to athletes resident in the County of Surrey (1964 boundary definition) **plus** the London Boroughs of Lambeth, Southwark and Wandsworth (the new SCSBRA boundary)
- Equipment:** Clothing is not subject to Equipment Control, but use of any equipment that may give an unfair advantage, or not within the spirit of the Rules, will not be allowed. Wind flags will be positioned on the range. Personal wind indicators are not permitted. Competitors should provide their own shooting mat. Telescopic sights may not be used.
- Prizes:** A trophy will be presented to the leading Surrey resident in the Prone Rifle events. Competition winners will receive Surrey gold, silver and bronze medals according to entries in each class on the following basis:

- Juniors:** Juniors will receive a £5.00 discount for each competition entered
ISSF definition – "Under the age of 21 on December 31st 2017".
The highest scoring junior man in competition 2, and woman in Competition 3.

Squadding notices will be sent by e-mail, so ensure your address is printed clearly. Otherwise – send S.A.E.

**IMPORTANT: Times shown on the entry form are the START time of the event (1st Match shot).
You will be called to the firing line 30 minutes before this time to set up your equipment and for your
preparation and sighting shots.**

SCSBRA reserves the right to cancel, alter or amend the competition at any stage and while SCSBRA will provide as much notice as it reasonably can, no liability shall attach to SCSBRA as a result of any such decision.
