Lord Roberts Centre, Bisley – Sunday 1st July 2018



GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Location:** The meeting will be held on the Malcolm Cooper Range, Lord Roberts Centre, Bisley Camp
- Reception:** On arrival, competitors should report to the Reception Desk to collect their bib numbers
- Targets:** All competitions will be shot on electronic scoring targets using Match Manager ranking software.
- Rules:**
- a) All shooting will be governed by ISSF (2017) rules in a single class in respect of timings.
 - b) The Prone Rifle event will be mixed male and female, with a Final.
 - c) There will be no Finals for the 50m Pistol or Three-position events.
 - d) The 3 x 40 events for men and women will be fired simultaneously, but with separate awards.
- Protests:** Any protests will be decided by three members of the Range Committee, which shall comprise the Meeting Organiser and two holders of ISSF Judges licences.
- Results:** Results will be displayed on the large screens during the Meeting and published on the Association's website as soon as possible after the meeting.
- Fees:** Participation in an event is provisional upon the full entry fee having been received by the Organiser at least 7 days before the start of the meeting, either by cheque or BACS. Unpaid entries will be removed from the start lists to allow other competitors to compete in popular events. Full or partial entry fees will only be refunded in exceptional circumstances.
- Firearms Act:** All competitors are deemed to possess and use the class of firearm for the competition(s) entered by virtue of membership of a Home Office approved Club, or other authority.
- Surrey Trophies:** Surrey CSBRA trophies will only be awarded to athlete's resident in the County of Surrey (1964 boundary definition).
- Equipment:** Clothing is not subject to compulsory Equipment Control but use of any equipment that may give an unfair advantage, or not within the spirit of the Rules, will not be allowed. Personal wind indicators are not permitted. Competitors should provide their own shooting mat. Telescopic sights may not be used.
- Prizes:** A trophy will be presented to the leading Surrey resident in the Prone Rifle events. Competition winners will receive Surrey medals proportionate to the number of entries in each event, as follows:
- Less than 6 entries = Gold only; 6 to 8 = Gold and Silver; 9 or more = Gold, Silver & Bronze
The highest scoring junior man and woman in Competition 2 will receive medals.
- Juniors:** Juniors will receive a £5.00 discount from their entry-fee.
ISSF definition – "Under the age of 21 on December 31st in the year of competition".

Squadding notices will be sent by e-mail, so ensure your address is printed clearly. Otherwise – send a S.A.E.

IMPORTANT: Times shown on the entry form are the START time of the event (1st Match shot). You will be called to the firing line **30 minutes before** this time to set up your equipment and for your preparation and sighting shots.
