The following conditions apply, regardless of the class competitors nominate:

- Those competitors in the leading two places in Classes B, C & D of the previous Meeting will be promoted one class for this meeting.
- If no average is submitted the competitor will be placed in Class A
- Any class with <5 entries will be combined with the class above
- The Range Committee reserves the right to reclassify a competitor at any time

GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Location

The meeting will be held at Worplesdon Target Shooting Club, Pitch Place, Worplesdon Road (A322) GU3 3LB. Find the WTSC facebook page using @worplesdontsc.

Parking

Plenty of parking will be available in the range car park.

Reception

Competitors should report to the meeting reception on arrival (next to the club room) to collect their targets and competition stickers.

Targets

NSRA 1989 Series targets will be used for prone shooting (.22 RF) and Series BR for Benchrest (.22 RF and Air Rifle). Competitors must affix the relevant competition stickers to each target and write the detail time, firing point number and their competitor number (if not on the sticker) on each card and backer.

Rain & Sun

The range has a covered firing point but little covered preparation, spectating or socialising space, so please come prepared to make your own shelter. You may pitch gazebos and the like in the car park, subject to there being room for competitors to park.

Eligibility

The event and most competitions in it are open to all comers. However only Surrey residents (1965 boundaries), individual members of the Surrey County Smallbore Rifle Association and current members of clubs affiliated to SCSBRA are eligible to win most trophies e.g. non-members may win a competition and receive the 1st place medal but the highest placed member will be awarded the trophy.

Rules

Shooting will be governed by NSRA rules except where otherwise stated. Competitors must comply with the SCSBRA Code of Conduct (available at www.surreysbra.org). Disputes will be decided by 3 or more members of the Range Committee, consisting of the Meeting Organiser or in their absence their deputy and the members of the Executive Committee of the Surrey County Small Bore Rifle Association.

Results and Prize Giving

Results will be displayed in an area next to the club house. Scores will be recorded as points scored. Competitors are responsible for ensuring that their scores are correctly recorded before leaving the meeting.

Winners will be announced shortly after the challenge period expires for the final detail, although no prizes will be distributed on the day. Medals and other awards will be mailed to individuals or clubs, and trophies will be presented at the SCSBRA Annual Dinner to be held at the Surrey Club, Bisley on Saturday evening, 7th December 2024.

Challenges

A score may be challenged on payment of £2 in cash which will be refunded if the challenge is upheld. Challenges must be made within 30 minutes of a score being posted. No score may be challenged after the close of the meeting.

Fees

Entry fees will be returned if the organiser is informed 48 hours before the start of the meeting.

Ammunition

Whilst limited supplies of ammunition may be available for purchase on the day, please do not rely on this and ensure you bring sufficient for the events you have entered.

Refreshments

Light refreshments will be available, with proceeds going to WTSC.

Squadding

All shooting will be squadded. Competitors must book their squadding in advance on their entry form. Competitors failing to shoot at their allocated time may only shoot at an alternative time subject to the discretion of the Range Committee. Any change to allocated details must first be agreed by the Range Committee.

Shooting times

Shooting will commence at 9.30am and will continue without a lunch break until the end of the last detail. Times may be extended at the discretion of the Range Committee.

Squad and Detail times

All details will be of 20 minutes duration. Ten minutes will be allowed between details to allow for target changing and moving equipment.

Sighters

Sighters will be unlimited within the 20 minutes shooting period.

Left-handed shooters

Left-handed shooters will be allocated the right-hand side of each firing point.

Disabled shooters

Please notify the Meeting Organiser of any special requirements.

Benchrest Shooters

Firing points will be reserved for benchrest shooters, with up to 3 benches in place for shooters to use. Shooters may bring their own benches if they prefer and will be responsible for putting the provided benches back in position once they've finished shooting.

Personal equipment

Personal wind indicators are not permitted, but wind indicators will be provided. Competitors should provide their own shooting mat and benchrest shooters may bring their own bench. Telescopic sights may be used in the .22 Any Sights, .22 Benchrest and Air Rifle Competitions.

Liability

Neither the Surrey County Small Bore Rifle Association nor WTSC accept any liability whatsoever for any loss of, or damage to, equipment used, stored or left on the range.

Medals

In each class and for each competition, Surrey gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded on the following basis, unless otherwise stated :-

- 1 - 5 entries: 1st place only
- 6 - 10 entries: 1st & 2nd places
- 11+ entries: 1st to 3rd places

The description of medals refers to the colour and not the metal content.

For comps 3 the NSRA Silver Medal will be awarded to the Surrey resident with the highest score who has not been awarded this medal before in any County Competition.

Dewar Badges

For comp 4, Dewar badges will be awarded to the top 20% of scorers in each class.

Submission of Entry Forms

To be emailed to surreyopenmeeting@gmail.com by Friday 31 August 2024. Entries will be accepted after this date, up to and including the meeting day, although available shooting times may be limited. Team & pairs entries can be made up to and including the meeting day, providing this is before the first team/pairs member shoot.
